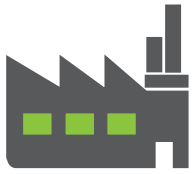

With a strong manufacturing presence, South Carolina has a high demand for recycled content feedstock. Manufacturers use recycled content materials for their finished products.



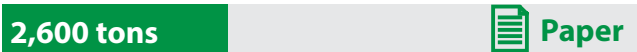

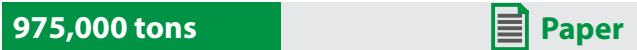
## A JOB GENERATOR

### CONSUMED PER DAY



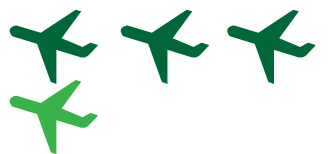
### ANNUAL DEMAND



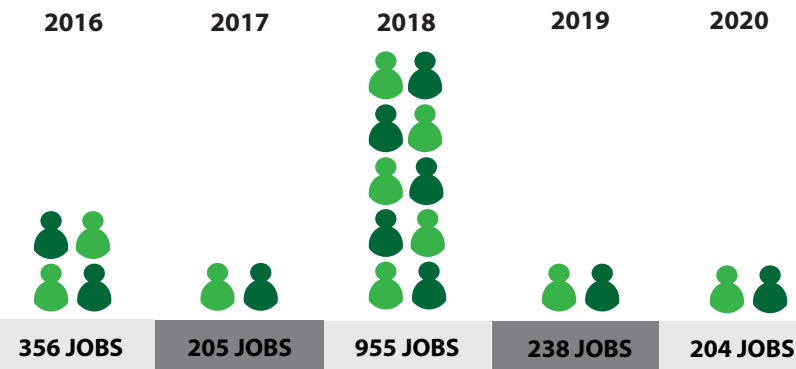
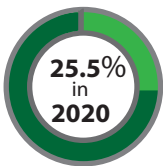
### REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

In FY2020, 1,211,116 tons of Municipal Solid Waste was recycled. That is the equivalent of 4,379 Boeing 787 planes, loaded at maximum take-off weight.

In FY2020, South Carolina's MSW recycling rate was 25.5%.



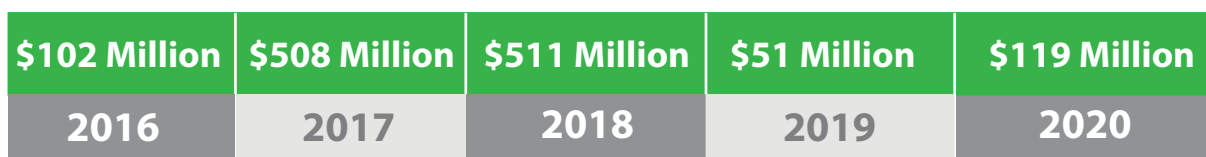

A Green State of Mind

With a business-friendly environment, it is easy being green in South Carolina. Since 2006, South Carolina has recruited more than **\$5.7 billion** in capital investment in the recycling-related sector. In 2014, the recycling industry had an economic impact of **\$13 billion** and supported **22,400 jobs**.
