From 2019 to 2023, the recycling industry in South Carolina announced **\$6.6 billion in capital investment, representing 5,008 new jobs in the state.**

In FY2023, **1,135,905 tons** of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) was recycled in South Carolina. That is the equivalent of **4,106 Boeing 787 planes**, loaded at maximum take-off weight.



South Carolina's MSW recycling rate was **20.9%** in FY2023.
